The American Cancer Society touches so many people on any given day... because dedicated volunteers and supporters like you are committed to making a difference in the fight against cancer! Cattle Baron's Ball started in Dallas in 1974 at the Star Brand Ranch. In 1984, a group of individuals organized the West Texas Tradition of **Round Up: A Cattle Baron's Ball** for the purpose of raising funds for the American Cancer Society. These few individuals multiplied into several hundred who became determined to organize an ongoing fundraising event that would assist in supporting research, education and service programs for this worthwhile organization, which now serves Midland and 18 surrounding counties. Celebrating its 30th birthday this year, **Round Up** has raised over 8.4 million dollars for the American Cancer Society in the Permian Basin.

Thanks to your generosity, Midland's **Round Up: A Cattle Baron's Ball** ranks 3rd in the state of Texas and 8th in the entire United States.



## YOUR ROUND UP DOLLARS AT WORK...

Having Cancer is hard, finding help shouldn't be. The Society provided over 3,600 services to 752 cancer patients in the Permian Basin Area last year through the following programs:

**PERSONAL HEALTH MANAGER** – 186 patients received a portfolio to organize information while undergoing treatment.

**HOPE LODGE** – 1,160 nights of lodging to cancer patients and their caregivers were provided by our Hope Lodge in Lubbock, TX, saving them over \$133,400 in hotel expenses to patients receiving cancer treatment.

**REACH TO RECOVERY®** – 23 visits were made through the Reach To Recovery® breast cancer mentoring program which provides peer support from a breast cancer survivor as well as recovery gifts.

**FREE BREAST PROSTHESIS PROGRAM** – 248 patients received 589 free breast prosthesis and bras.

**FREE WIGS, HATS & SCARVES** – 41 patients received this gift through the Midland and Odessa offices.

**LOOK GOOD, FEEL BETTER** – Makeover classes for patients in treatment, includes a free make-up kit, tips on skin, nail and wig care, and dealing with hair loss.

**TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE** – 188 patients received gas cards saving them \$37,600 in gas while traveling to and from treatment.

**ROAD TO RECOVERY** – Volunteers drive patients to and from their treatments.

**CANCER SURVIVORS NETWORK** – An online support group for cancer patients and their families.

**SUPPORT GROUPS** – Support groups for cancer patients and their families.

**GUESTROOM PROGRAM** – Free or discounted hotel rooms for patients traveling from out of town and requiring overnight stays.

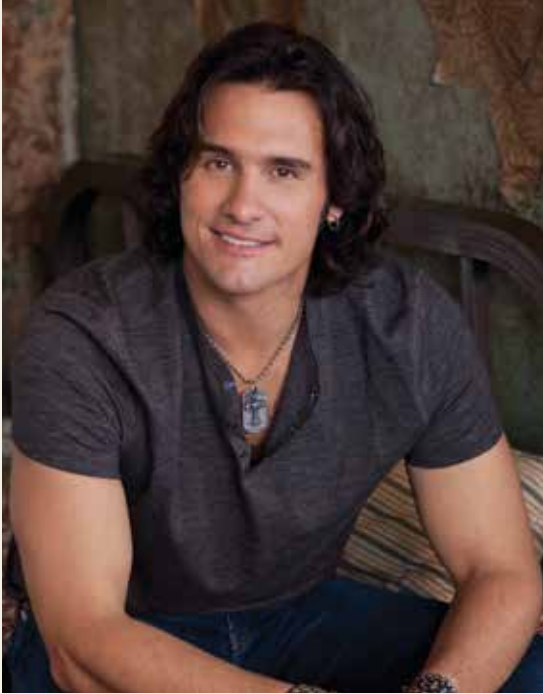

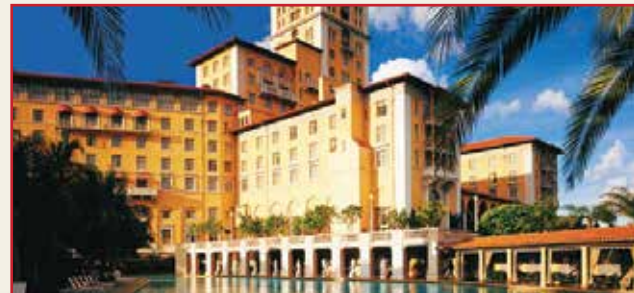
